③ MAST/RIG & SAILS

- Step Mast, Tune, Pin & Refit Boom
Remove mast from storage, crane mast in, re-tension standing rigging and secure, fit boom and all running rigging
- Bend Sails On
Refit sails including battens, reef lines & control lines, luff slides/cars and sail covers/stackpacks.
Furling sails operations/handling will be double checked.

④ SERVICE WORK:

- Pre-season mast & rig survey
We survey the rig and all rigging related parts of the yacht - A detailed report with images will be provided
- Masthead gear reinstate
VHF, anemometer, TV aerial, navigation lights & Windex will be put back from winter storage/care.
- Spars - wash, polish & protect
Masts & booms will be washed, then coated from top to bottom with 'Hempel - Alu Protect' .
- Liferaft - reinstate
If your life raft has come back from servicing allow us to refit it for you.
- Deckgear - service
Deck organisers, clutches, travellers, blocks and all moving parts - will be flushed, inspected and re-lubricated.
- Mainsail track - lubricate
From top to bottom of the sail track, batten cars will be serviced and lubricated to aid hoisting the mainsail.
- Anchor chain & docklines
We will check your anchor chain & docklines to ensure they are safe and ready for the forthcoming season.
- Winches - service
Winches will be broken down, stripped, de-greased, inspected and re-greased ready for the sailing season.
- Running Rigging - wash & service
All halyards, controls lines & sheets - will be run through our professional rope washer, then inspected and serviced with frayed ends repaired and whippings applied where necessary.
- Running rigging - reinstate
We will refit all running rigging which may have been removed for washing or winter storage
- Refit Sprayhood & Dodgers
Sprayhood will be reinstated and strapped up accordingly. Dodgers will be laced back into place.
- Rig Tension - check & tune
Standing rigging tensions will be checked and mast will be tuned to ensure it is in column and straight.

5 MAST ELECTRICS:

- Owner to reconnect mast electrics
- MYH Marine Team to reconnect mast electrics *
- MYH Marine Team to carry out mast electrical safety check *

(Carry out inspection of mast wiring & navigation light operation and carry out S.W.R. test, this checks the performance of the vhf and condition of vhf aerial.)
